We aim to engage the children in activities that enrich their understanding and where possible link our maths and English learning to our topics (for example we read War Horse in our English lessons in our Years 5 and 6 World War 1 topic).

Our KS2 science curriculum is taught through Empiribox. This provides the children with a science curriculum with a practical approach that goes far beyond the limits of the national curriculum.
