

Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum

In the early years we provide a play based curriculum in a safe and nurturing environment. Children are encouraged to use the inside and outside learning environment on a daily basis to become independent learners. We have a new topic each term in which create fully immersive environments for the children. The Early years curriculum is created for each child to be the leader of their learning. We change plans and topics to go along with the children's interests. Throughout the year the children are assessed against 17 Early Learning Goals with the expectation that children will be working within these by the end of the year.
