We hope you have had an enjoyable and restful half term holiday. We have a brand new term packed full of exciting opportunities to learn from and have fun together.

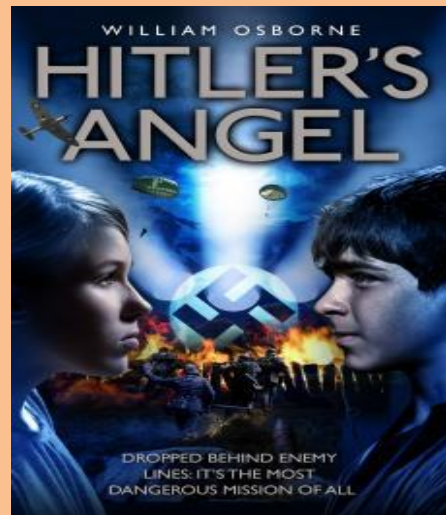
This term we hope to build on the fantastic work the children completed in Term 1. We would like to challenge all the children to achieve 100% attendance as this is vital to them achieving their full potential.

In Numeracy, we will be learning all about fractions including; how to find equivalent fractions, calculating fractions of amounts and developing our understanding of adding, subtracting, multiplying and dividing fractions.. Also, we will continue to develop our reasoning and explaining skills during problem solving activities.

It is, as ever, extremely important that the children can recall their times tables. Please practice these regularly at home. There will also be Mathletics tasks to practice at home.

This term we will be immersing ourselves in the novel *Hitler's Angel* by William Osborne. This narrative is based around events in World War II (WW2) which we will be linking to our topic work.

We will be finding out about evacuation, rationing, the Blitz and we will also be trying our hand at World War II cookery.



PE will continue to be on a Thursday afternoon so please ensure your child has their PE kit with them on this day.

During Science, we will continue to explore the topic of electricity through a variety of practical experiments. We will be applying our knowledge of electrical circuits to design and create our own burglar alarms. In addition, we will develop our understanding about electricity from magnetism.
