

Year 1 Curriculum Information
Term 3 Update.

English through the Creative Curriculum

The Great Fire of London.

We will be learning about The Great Fire of London. How the fire started, the consequences of the fire and how it changed people's lives. During our lessons we will be focussing on:

- Punctuation - Full stops, capital letters, question marks and exclamation marks.
- Reading our sentences to check they make sense.
- Using descriptive language to add detail to our work.
- Using our phonic skills to spell known and new words.
- Reading a variety of different books.
- Daily Guided Reading and daily RWInc sounds.
- Designing our own houses.
- Investigating how people lived at the time of The Great Fire of London.
- Understanding how to keep ourselves safe in the event of a fire.
- Role play using a bakery setting.

Maths

- Counting to 100.
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's.
- Telling the time - o'clock and half past.
- Place Value of 2 and 3 digit numbers.
- Measuring the length of objects.
- Measuring the height of objects.
- Solve one step problems that involve addition and subtraction.

Science

Everyday Objects

- We will be learning about wood, plastic, glass, metal, water and rocks.
- We will be discovering which everyday objects are made from each material and why.
- We will be conducting experiments to discover the best uses for different materials.
- We will be investigating where we can find examples of each material around the school.

Computing

- This terms focus will be internet safety and how to use a computer without sharing personal information and details.
- We will also be using the Mathletics site to support the children's maths learning.

RE

We will continue to learn about **Christianity**.

- This will include learning about Friendships that Jesus made.
- How we can care for others in our community from different religious backgrounds.

PE

PE lessons have changed to Thursday.
Lessons will be completed both inside and outside. Children will continue to focus on the following:

- Basic throwing and catching skills using a range of different equipment.
- Spatial awareness and safety.
- Co-ordination and stability.
- Movement.
- Team work and games.

Go-Givers

This term we will be learning about:

- Rules and why it is important that these are followed by everyone.
- Having different views and opinions.
- Respecting others.
- How to keep the environment clean and tidy and why this matters.

Other information

- Please can all children bring a named, warm coat to school every day as the outside area for Year 1 is now in use and the children will be using this area to support their learning on a daily basis.
- Please can the Home/School contact book be brought to school every day.
- PE is on Thursday (indoors and outside). Please ensure that your child has a PE kit in school on this day with appropriate footwear.
- Love to Learn homework tasks are designed to be completed over the course of the term but please send your child's book into school every Thursday so that staff can check the work that has been completed.
