

Year 1 Curriculum Information - Term 4 Update.

English through the Creative Curriculum

Dinosaur

We will be learning about Dinosaurs this term and during our lessons we will be focussing on:

- Using our phonic skills to read and spell words.
- Adding a range of punctuation to our work.
- Using adjectives to describe events.
- Composing simple poetry using rhyme.
- Daily Guided Reading and daily RWInc sounds.
- Designing our own dinosaurs.
- Investigating where and how dinosaurs lived.
- Completing a dinosaur bone dig.
- Role play using model dinosaurs and masks.
- Creating pictures using dinosaur stampers.

Maths

- Counting forwards and backwards from given numbers.
- Learning how to multiply numbers using arrays.
- Learning how to divide numbers.
- Recognising and naming fractions (whole, halves and quarters).
- Solve one step mathematical problems.

Science

Seasonal Changes

- Changes in the weather between seasons.
- Observing and describing changing temperature, rainfall and wind direction.
- Collecting and recording data.
- Conducting fair tests.
- Staying safe in the sun.

Computing

- Opening and saving Word documents.
- Using Power Points and text boxes.
- Following instructions and learning why these are important.
- Mathletics to support maths learning.

- Reading the Easter story and ordering the main events.
- Focussing on Palm Sunday and why Jesus was welcomed by the crowds.

PE

- Safely setting up and putting away equipment.
- Working in pairs, small and large teams.
- Turn taking.
