Amazing Animals

We will be learning about lots of different animals this term. During our lessons we will be focussing on:

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Maths

- Place value within 50.
- Counting in 2's, 5's and 10's from given numbers.
- Measuring length and height using centimetres and meters.
- Measuring weight and volume using millilitres and litres.
- Comparing, describing and solving practical mathematical problems.

Science

- Identifying and naming parts of the human body.
- To describe and compare animal bodies.
- Grouping animals.
- Sorting animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores.
- Studying our senses and how we use them.

Computing

- Changing font, colour and size in word documents.
- Continue to use Power Point.
- Beginning to understand and use coding to make a simple game.

- Learning about synagogues and what happens there.
- Focussing on Shabbat and why it is important to Jewish families.

PE

- Team games.
- Ball skills such as throwing and catching.
- Running races.
- Hand/eye coordination.
- Spatial awareness.
- Movement - linked to our animal topic.
