Numeracy	Literacy
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • During Term 1 we will spend a lot of time working on our understanding of number. • We will be learning about place value in three and four digit numbers. • We will be working on our 3 and 4 times table but we will also recap the 2s, 5s and 10s. • We will be learning to add and subtract using the column method. • In Term 2 we will be learning to multiply 1-digit by 2 and 3-digit numbers using the grid method. • We will be learning to divide up to 3-digit by 1-digit using the 'bus stop' method. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • In term 1 we will be learning about the book: Harry Potter and the Philosopher's Stone. • We will be writing story openings, story endings and character descriptions. • Also, we will be learning to write information texts about a number of different topics. • In Term 2 we will be learning from the book: Around the World in 80 Days. • We will be learning to write persuasive letters, informative letters, diary entries and narratives. • During both terms, we will be experiencing and writing various forms of poetry.
