## School Uniform

Dear Parents / Carers

We are very proud of our school and all of our children and would like your help in ensuring that we keep the children looking smart as we go into the new school year. Having a smart uniform helps children take pride in their school and fosters a sense of community along with helping children to feel equal.

Uniform	PE Kit (only for Years 1-6)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Grey skirt, pinafore dress, formal shorts or trousers or blue and white checked dress</li><li>• Plain navy cardigan, pullover (£9), fleece (£12) or v-neck sweatshirt</li><li>• White shirt or polo shirt (Yrs Foundation – 4)</li><li>• White shirt (Yrs 5 and 6)</li><li>• Regis Manor Tie with a gold stripe – (Yrs 5 and 6 - £5)</li><li>• Regis Manor <b>navy blue</b> blazer (Yrs 5 and 6) with a Regis Manor badge (£5)</li><li>• Black school shoes or sandals - <b>no trainers, boots or high heels</b></li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• PE bag (£5)</li><li>• Navy blue shorts</li><li>• White t-shirt</li><li>• Indoor PE should be completed in bare feet.</li><li>• Plain navy blue tracksuit</li><li>• Black or white trainers for outdoor PE</li></ul>

Please note:

- The school follows the Trust policy on jewellery and earrings and therefore has a **no earring policy**. Earrings should be removed prior to children coming into school. **Children who wear earrings into school will not be allowed to participate in PE lessons or play on the playground – an alternate provision inside will be put in place instead.**
- Hair ties should be either plain black or dark blue and all hair longer than shoulder length must be tied back when the children are at school (this includes both boys and girls). Large bows or other ornamental hair pieces should not be worn to school. Children will be asked to remove them if they are worn.
- No make-up should be worn at school and this includes nail varnish.
- Children should not bring mobile phones into school. However, in exceptional circumstances, if a phone has to be brought to school permission should be sought by completing a form which can be obtained from your child's class teacher or from the office. Mobile phones must then be handed into the school office for safe keeping during the school day.

Please can I also remind you that the children can bring in fruit to eat at breaktimes (only fruit products – either fresh or dried) and that children having packed lunches should not be bringing in fizzy drinks (or drinks in glass bottles) and also not any chocolate bars. Please avoid sending your children with nuts. As far as possible they should have a focus on healthy food.
