

PE Kit

You need your PE kit in school at all times. You will have a set P.E day however sometimes we may do extra activities where you need your kit. This comprises of a white t-shirt, navy blue shorts, white socks and trainers (outside).

In the winter, you should bring a tracksuit (any colour). No jewellery is to be worn and please remember you also need a hair band if you have long hair. If you are going to have your ears pierced over the summer, it is best to do it at the start of the holiday so that they have plenty of time to heal before September's PE lessons.

Snacks / Water

Home / School Contact

You will be given a new planner to use during Year 1. Read the important information in it with your parents/carers at the beginning of term. It is really important that you bring the planner to school every day. If your parents/carers have written a note to us, please show us your planner in the morning.

There will be parents evenings during the year where your teacher, parents/carers and yourself can discuss your progress.

Behaviour

Remember that you should be showing your best behaviour at all times, just like you did in Transition week. We will be creating our class rules together when we return in September,

It is going to be an exciting year! Learning will take place both inside and outside of the classroom. We will be providing lots of interesting activities for you to explore and learn from.

In June you will take part in a Phonic Screening Assessment. More information will be given about these tests closer to the date, but we will work hard throughout the year to ensure you're ready. Make sure you do lots of reading so that you practise using the sounds you have learnt.

Homework

As you know, all children at Regis Manor are asked to read to an adult 4x a week, and this counts as part of your homework.

We will write down the book title that you will be reading, then please ask your parents/carers to sign your planner each time you have read. We are always interested to read their comments about your reading.

Your Love to Learn work which will be sent home will link to the work you have been learning in class. You will earn points for every piece of work you do.

This could lead to a super certificate at the end of each term!

ICT

You will also be given a Mathletics password so that you can do activities at home and earn more certificates! We will be visiting the ICT Suite every week to learn new skills on the computer.

PE
