Homework

As you know, all children at Regis Manor are asked to read to an adult 4 times a week, and this counts as part of your homework. Write down the book title and pages that you have read each day, then please ask your parents to sign your planner at the end of the week; we are always interested to read their comments about your reading. If you have a book at home that you would like to use as a reading book, that is fine. If not you can choose one from the book corner.

We are using the same style of home learning this year. You have a learning log and different tasks will be set at the start of the term; you can choose your tasks each week and earn points!

You will also have the Rainbow Maths level that you are working on. You may practise this as much as you like but the more you practise, the quicker you will improve!

You will also have spellings every week. You will have time in school to do this but you can also complete them at home. Your parents can set up their own account to see how well you are doing!

If there is a reason why your homework cannot be given in on time, please ask your parents to write a note in your planner.

To keep them looking smart, please do not write or draw on the cover of any of your books.

Organisation

You need to take responsibility for remembering what you need for school and to hand your homework in on time. If you lose something that belongs to you, try lost property. If you have tried really hard to look for something yourself but still can't find it, an adult will help. It makes a big difference if all your equipment is named—things can be returned to you quickly if we know who it belongs to!
