If you have a book at home that you would like to use as a reading book, that is fine. If not you can choose one from the book corner.

You have been given a 'Love to Learn' log and different tasks have been set at the start of the term; you can choose your tasks each week and earn points! We will aim to share 'some' of the fantastic work produced on a Friday afternoon. Do not stress about bringing Topic homework in each week as we know sometimes some of the tasks take longer than a week to create therefore take your time and bring it in once it is ready.

You also have Mathematics tasks and spellings every week. You have time in school to do this but you can also complete them at home. Your parents can set up their own account to see how well you are doing!

If there is a reason why your homework cannot be given in on time, please ask your parents to write a note in your planner.
